OVERVIEW


Everyone paying attention to the weather knows our climate is changing, *but did you know this?*

- The US has produced more greenhouse gasses than any other nation
- Methane from fracking is a more destructive greenhouse gas than carbon dioxide
- Methane is leaking from hundreds of uncapped wells in Pennsylvania

IMPACTS

What's at stake if we don't act now is **MORE**:

- Severe floods
- Severe droughts
- Frequent and devastating wildfires
- Heat waves and frigid polar vortexes
- Severe storms, tornados, and hurricanes
- Famine and starvation
- Unlivable areas in the world, causing more displaced people and increased migration
- Species extinction
- Glacial melting and rising sea levels that will flood coastal cities like Miami, NYC, LA and the Jersey Shore



SOLUTIONS

MORE Democrats in Congress

Democrats just passed the largest U.S. investment ever in climate. It will cut greenhouse gas emissions 40% by 2030. ALL Republican Senators voted against it.

Democratic Governors to veto Republican-passed legislation that protects polluters instead of people and the planet

Democratic-controlled State Legislatures to pass regulations favorable to clean energy production

PA DEMOCRATIC CANDIDATES

John Fetterman for US Senate

- Believes climate change is an existential threat
- Supports transitioning to clean energy as soon as possible while creating good clean-energy Union jobs

Chrissy Houlahan for US House Rep

- Supports 100% electric energy from renewable sources by 2035
- Fighting for binding legislation to stop climate change in its tracks
- Supported the Great American Outdoors Act

Josh Shapiro for Governor

- Supports expansion of PA's clean energy portfolio, more electric car infrastructure and investments in clean energy R&D
- Supports capping mines and wells to stop methane gas emissions
- Believes protecting jobs and the environment are compatible goals

PA State Legislators (House & Senate):

- Support RGGI, a multi-state program to reduce carbon emissions from power plants
- Have a pro-environment voting record of 83%, with over a third scoring 100%

PA REPUBLICAN CANDIDATES

Mehmet Oz for US Senate

- Climate change denier claiming greenhouse gas emissions don't heat the planet
- Supports additional fracking and believes regulations are "heavy handed"
- Would increase America's dependence on fossil fuels

Guy Ciarrocchi for US House Rep

- Supports more fracking and pipelines
- Wants PA to be the #1 U.S. natural gas produce, making our state a top producer of harmful methane

Doug Mastriano for Governor

- Refers to climate change as "fake science"
- Supports drilling in State Parks and forests
- Opposes RGGI

PA State Legislators (House & Senate)

- Voted to prohibit PA from joining RGGI
- Have a pro-environment voting record of 3%, with 84% scoring ZERO
