Freedom over our bodies Being able to make decisions about our body and family size is a critical component of freedom - perhaps the most basic of freedoms. Pregnancy is a complex medical condition that carries tremendous risks. We cannot go back to a time when women are refused treatment for life threatening pregnancies. And now Republicans have introduced a bill to ban abortions *nationally*. The bill contains no exceptions after 15 weeks, when abortions are almost always to save the mother's life or when the fetus is not viable. Republicans are also looking to ban *contraception*. 96% of US House Republicans voted against protecting access to contraception.



Freedom to live in a healthy environment Severe floods, droughts, devastating wildfires, and melting ice caps are all symptoms of a sick planet. If left to continue, parts of the planet will become unlivable, leading to widespread famine and starvation, displaced people, and mass migration. Ultimately, we all will feel this pressure. WARNING! Republicans are Determined to Eliminate Checks-and-Balances

The Republican majority in Harrisburg have embraced a new trick to push through their unpopular policies: veto-proof constitutional amendments. To amend the Pennsylvania constitution, the PA House and Senate must pass a bill by a simple majority in 2 consecutive sessions. It then becomes a ballot question, and typically appears on our ballots in an off-year primary when fewer people vote. If a majority vote YES, it immediately becomes law. The Governor cannot veto it, and the courts cannot overturn it. The Philadelphia Bar Association passed a resolution this year opposing the use of constitutional amendments as a substitute for the checks-and-balances of the legislative process.

In a late-night session last Spring, Republicans passed a surprise bill to place 5 proposed amendments on the ballot. The amendments would make it harder to vote, make it easier for politicians to interfere with or not count our votes, shift power from the Governor to the Legislature, AND take away the guarantee of a woman's right to abortion services. If Republicans win control of the PA House and Senate in November, these questions will be on our ballots in 2023, a risk we cannot allow. **This election it is CRITICAL to vote for all Democrats for the Pennsylvania House and Senate.**
